

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
PIERDOMENICO BACCALARIO

He has collaborated for over twenty years with the organisation of Lucca Comics & Games, writes for two major Italian newspapers.


Today he is considered one of the leading Italian children's authors and the most translated abroad.

ATTILIO


Attilio Cassinelli – a.k.a. Attilio – was a painter, designer, and illustrator. Since the '70s he revolutionized children's book illustration with his ability to express so much with his simple, geometric style, stemming from his first activity of drawing puppets for children: with wide black outlines and solid colors, he created characters with well-defined, highly expressive personalities.

In the 60's, in Bologna, he met Renato Giunti and their historic collaboration began.

From the '60s through the early '90s, he was among the most popular illustrators: his drawings and iconic signature appeared on clothing in Japan, his illustrations from Pinocchio on luxury porcelain tableware in Italy.

Working in collaboration with his daughter Alessandra, in 2016 Attilio returned to the publishing world with Lapis Edizioni. He passed away in 2024, aged 101. Over the course of his long career, Attilio has received


Over the course of his long career, Attilio has received numerous national and international awards, including the Special Jury Prize of the Andersen Prize in 2017, the 2017 Premio Nati per Leggere (Cappuccetto Rosso), the 2017 Microeditoria Quality Prize (Cappuccetto Rosso), and the Bologna Ragazzi Lifetime Achievement Award in 2019.






YUME'S DREAMS








NAVELGAZE and INTHECLOUDS




WHAT A MESS PETIT BOUDINI!
